

Corrigendum to
“Self-Compassion and Aggression in College Students”
(2017, Vol. 32, No. 4, 235-241; <https://doi.org/10.24123/aipj.v32i4.854>)

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After the publication of our article titled “Self-Compassion and Aggression in College Students” (Djajadisastra, 2017), we noted that some parts of the article need to be edited.

After discussion with the editors, I have decided to:

1. Add a phrase: “belas-diri” in the Indonesian abstract (p. 235) before (*self-compassion*) in the 3rd sentence and eliminate “(*self-compassion*)” in the 4th sentence.

The edited part of the abstract is as follows:

“ ... Penulis menduga bahwa belas-diri (*self-compassion*) berkaitan dengan agresivitas. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara belas-diri dan agresivitas pada mahasiswa.

2. Change “greatfully” into “gratefully” in the footer (p. 235).

3. Change the word “we” at several places into “the author”.

4. Eliminate “ANOVA test ” words (p. 238) from the Method section, and change “were” into “was.”

The edited part of the article is as follows:

Data Analyses

... The independent sample t-test was used to compare participants' levels of self-compassion

5. Refine the results statements (p. 238) in accordance with APA Style.

The edited part of the article is as follows:

Results

... Using an independent sample t-test, the author found that there was a significant difference in the level of aggression based on participants' gender ($t(298) = 2.779, p = .006 < .05$).

6. Add one reference to my article, i.e. reference to the statement, "Aggression was measured using a modified version of the Aggression Questionnaire (AQ) by Buss and Perry (1992)." (p. 237).

This will be added after reference "Bushman, B. J., & Anderson, C. A. (2001). Is it time to pull the plug on the hostile versus instrumental aggression dichotomy? *Psychological Review*, 108(1), 273-279."

The edited part of the article (p. 240) is as follows:
